- Appliances (extra charge for items with Freon)
- Concrete, dirt and asphalt
- Garage clean-out items
- Furniture
- Scrap metals
- Wood waste (*no treated wood*)
- Construction materials

- Kitchen/bathroom sinks and tubs
- "Spring cleanup" items
- General waste

Prohibited Waste:

- Aerosol cans (*full*)
- Ammunition
